OPEN CONTAINER LAW

“It is prohibited to consume or possess any alcoholic beverage in an open container on any public street, sidewalk, public parking facility or private property when the owner has not given consent to consume alcohol or have an open container on the property. The law includes consuming or possessing alcoholic beverages in or around Ben Hill Griffin Stadium. Violators are subject to a civil citation.”

GAINESVILLE POLICE DEPARTMENT PARTY PATROL TIPS

- Don't get too noisy or the police will be called for a noise complaint.
- Don't let your guests venture onto neighboring property owned by others.
- Overcrowded parties tend to get broken up by the police.
- Only invite guests you know.
- Only allow guests that are 21 to consume alcohol at your residence—both the under aged person and the host will be charged with a violation.
- The host/hostess should present proper identification when asked by an officer.
- Make sure your guests are not parked in “no parking zones,” or in visitor parking.
- Excessive trash in one's yard can incur the host/hostess a fine.
